RE: Cancellation of 12/8 and 12/9 H1N1 Flu Vaccination Clinics

ALMA, WI – The first significant snow storm of the year is anticipated to begin on December 8 and continue through December 9. As this weather may threaten the safety of our residents travelling to and from the previously scheduled H1N1 influenza vaccination clinics, we are cancelling both the clinic in Mondovi on December 8 and the clinic in Cochrane on December 9. This information will be communicated to radio and television stations throughout the area and will be posted to the Buffalo County and Great Rivers 2-1-1 websites.

We will hold a mass H1N1 flu clinic as follows:

*Transportation to and from Alma will be available from Mondovi and CFC schools.

This clinic will be for individuals in target groups, but no individual will be turned away. The vaccine is recommended for everyone. Only individuals who have had lab confirmed H1N1 flu or who are allergic to eggs or the seasonal flu vaccine should not receive the H1N1 vaccine. It is made in the same way as the seasonal flu vaccine and has a very good safety record.
