A RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER FUNDS FROM THE BUFFALO COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT BUDGET TO THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT BUDGET FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE COOPERATIVE USE OF THE ~~2014~~ 2019 FORD F-150 SQUAD BETWEEN EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT, AND FOR THE LEASE OF A NEW SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT SQUAD VEHICLE.

WHEREAS, there is value for Buffalo County Emergency Management to have a vehicle prepared to respond to natural disasters that occur in the County as well as to other emergency incidents such as large fires, rescue situations, train derailments, evacuations and other incidents to which Emergency Management can lend support, and for administrative travel, and

WHEREAS, the vehicle can be stocked with supplies and equipment that are required and/or would prove useful at the scene of a natural disaster or other emergency in support of the County's emergency services, such as emergency radio, lights and

WHEREAS, Buffalo County Emergency Management has maintained budgeted funds in the amount of \$22,368.17 to put towards the purchase of such a vehicle, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Department F-150 is currently configured as a law enforcement patrol vehicle, and can be maintained in such a way as to be available for patrol duties in a short amount of time, and

WHEREAS, the opportunity presents itself for a cooperative effort between the Emergency Management and Sheriff's Departments to meet the unique needs for a vehicle for Emergency Management, while maintaining another reserve squad that would be available for Sheriff's Department use when needed, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Department would have the opportunity, utilizing the funds from Emergency Management, to lease a new squad with updated equipment to replace the 2016 truck, which will be transferred to Emergency Management.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Buffalo County Law Enforcement and Emergency Management Committee hereby grants authorization for Buffalo County Emergency Management to transfer \$22,368.17 to the Buffalo County Sheriff's Department and for the Sheriff's Department to use said funds to lease a new squad and equip that vehicle appropriately for 2019 and budget in the coming years for the completion of a four (4) year lease with the excess for this year placed into 2020's Capital Asset fund to continue the lease for the next year.
