A RESOLUTION TO PURCHASE ELECTRONIC MESSAGE BOARDS USING AMERICAN RECOVERY PLAN FUNDS

WHEREAS in December 2019, a novel strain of coronavirus known as COVID-19 was detected, and COVID-19 has continued to spread throughout the world, including to the United States and the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS the federal government, state governments, and local governments are working together to contain the further spread of the disease and treat existing cases; and

WHEREAS on March 11, 2021, President Biden signed the \$1.9 trillion American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 creating the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds to provide substantial infusion of resources to continue to decrease the spread of the virus and bring the pandemic under control; and,

WHEREAS Buffalo County is anticipating receiving \$1,263,641 in May of 2021 and \$1,263,641 in May of 2022 for a total award of \$2,527,282 directly from the federal government; and,

WHEREAS the Buffalo County Highway Committee at their April 13th meeting recognized the need to purchase two (2) electronic message boards from Sherwin Industries, Inc., to direct traffic and increase safety at public health vaccination clinics held in the County; and,

WHEREAS public health vaccination clinics play a critical role in the efforts to reduce the spread of COVID-19.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors approve the Highway Department purchasing two (2) Wanco WTMMB Message Boards, warranty and accessories from Sherwin Industries, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$38,000.00 using the American Recovery Plan Funds (ARPA) received by the federal government to assist in public outreach and safety to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.




