

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE
BUFFALO COUNTY ZONING COMMITTEE

Please be advised that the Buffalo County Zoning Committee will hold a public hearing to consider amendments to Chapters 7, 8 & 9 of “The Buffalo County Zoning Ordinance” at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, July 11, 2019 in the Third Floor County Board Room, Buffalo County Courthouse, Alma, Wisconsin.

Buffalo County recently completed a comprehensive revision of the Zoning Ordinance. Amendments to the Zoning Ordinance are being proposed. WI Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection approved certification to the ANR-40 zoning district as a Farmland Preservation Zoning District provided specific edits would be established to this Zoning District. Language is to be added to the Zoning Ordinance regarding structure height requirements. In the interest of reducing complexity and also meaningfully reducing construction costs for new poultry barn owners, amendments are proposed for the “Poultry Barns” specific use.

The Zoning Committee will convene immediately following this public hearing and make a recommendation to the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors, who will consider adoption of the proposed amendments on August 26, 2019 at a regular meeting of the Board.

You are further notified that copies of the amendments are on file and open for public inspection in the office of the Buffalo County Clerk and Buffalo County Zoning Office for a period of not less than two weeks prior to the July 11, 2019 Buffalo County Zoning Committee public hearing date and County Board of Supervisors consideration in accordance with s. 59.69(5)(e) Wisconsin Statutes.

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
