A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL LAND ACCESS PROGRAM FUNDS (FLAP)

WHEREAS, in 2006, Buffalo County entered into an agreement with the Wisconsin DNR to be the Local Sponsor for a DOT Enhancement Grant that was for the design and construction of the Great River State Trail - Winona Connector from the Winona Bridge to the Town of Buffalo Park hereinafter referred to as Phase I; and,


WHEREAS, Buffalo County has been awarded grant funding in the amount of \$2,093,026 for Phase I and is eligible for additional future state and federal funding to complete this project; and,

WHEREAS, the utilization of Federal Land Access Program Funds (FLAP) would provide funding to complete the final 2.8 mile section of the Winona Connector bridging the bluffs from Wisconsin and Minnesota to provide access to over 200 plus miles of trails in Wisconsin and connect to the 3000 plus mile Mississippi River Trail referred to as Phase II; and,

WHEREAS, Phase II is anticipated to cost approximately \$1,900,000 for design, engineering, construction, and inspection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors hereby grants authorization to the Buffalo County Administrative Coordinator to complete an application for Federal Land Access Program funding available for Phase II of the Great River State Trail – Winona Connector.
