**A RESOLUTION TO CHANGE A FULL-TIME AGING DIRECTOR POSITION TO A FULL-TIME TRANSPORTATION AND ADULT PROTECTION SERVICES MANAGER POSITION**

WHEREAS, counties are mandated by the State of Wisconsin to provide adult protection services to aid elder adults and adults-at-risk who have been abused, neglected or exploited; and

WHEREAS, in 2018 Pepin County began contracting with Buffalo County for the provision of adult protection services (APS); and


WHEREAS, the increased statewide demand for APS coupled with the proportionate growth of the Buffalo and Pepin Counties' population over age 60 have contributed to the dramatic increase of APS referrals and guardianship requests; and

WHEREAS, the shift of duties proposed for changing the aging director position to a transportation and adult protection services manager position increases capacity to meet the APS needs of Buffalo and Pepin Counties and satisfies the Wisconsin Department of Transportation's requirement to clearly designate a staff member to be responsible for Buffalo County's specialized transportation contract with Pepin County; and

WHEREAS, the proposed 2020 budget for the Buffalo County Department of Health and Human Services supports the implementation of the proposed changes to this position without increasing county funding.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Buffalo County Board of Supervisors hereby grants authorization to change the Aging Director position to a Transportation and Adult Protection Services Manager position and for the position to be reviewed and evaluated no later than December 31, 2020.
